

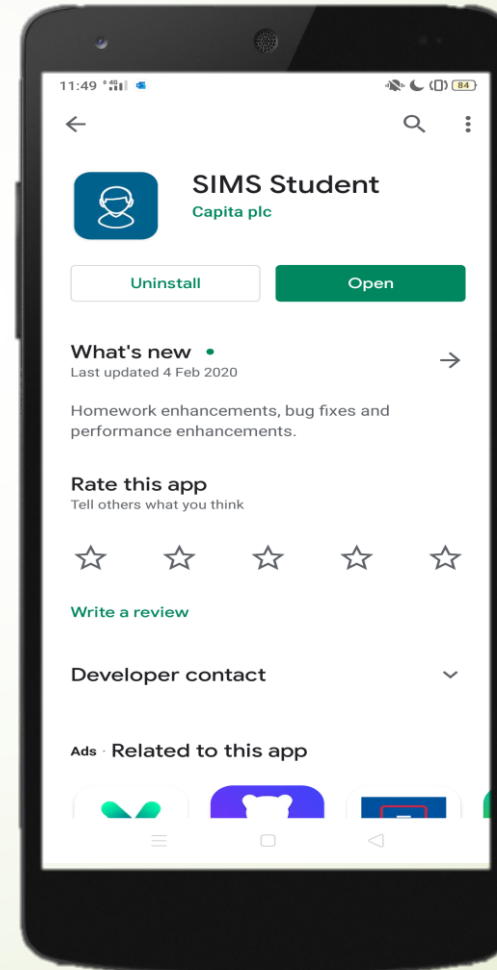
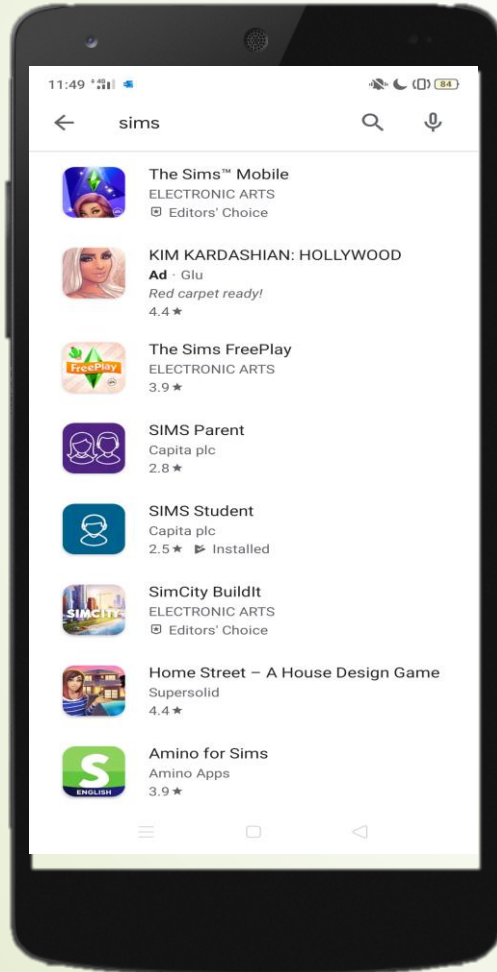


How to access work set on SIMS

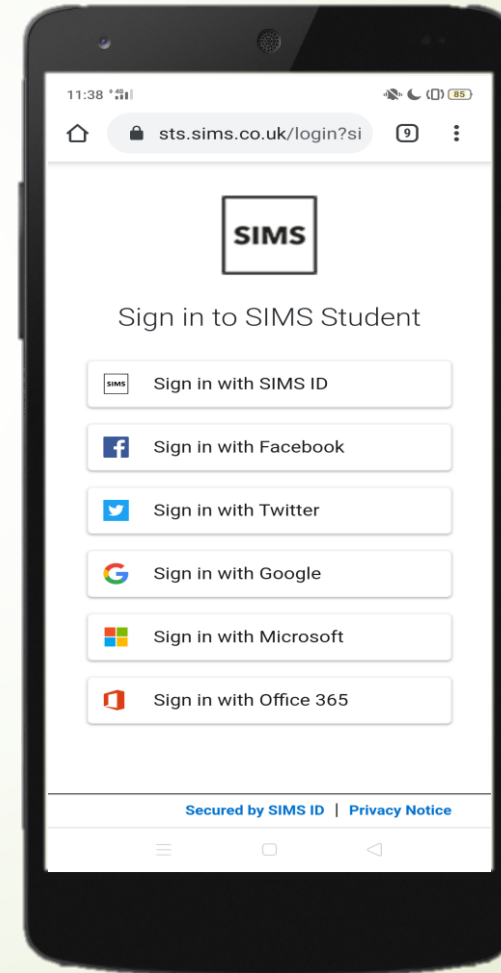
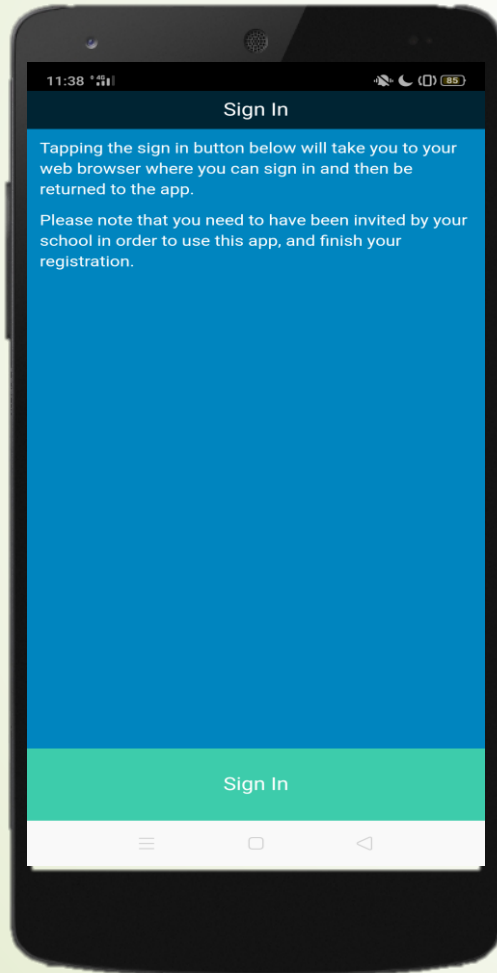


On Students Phones

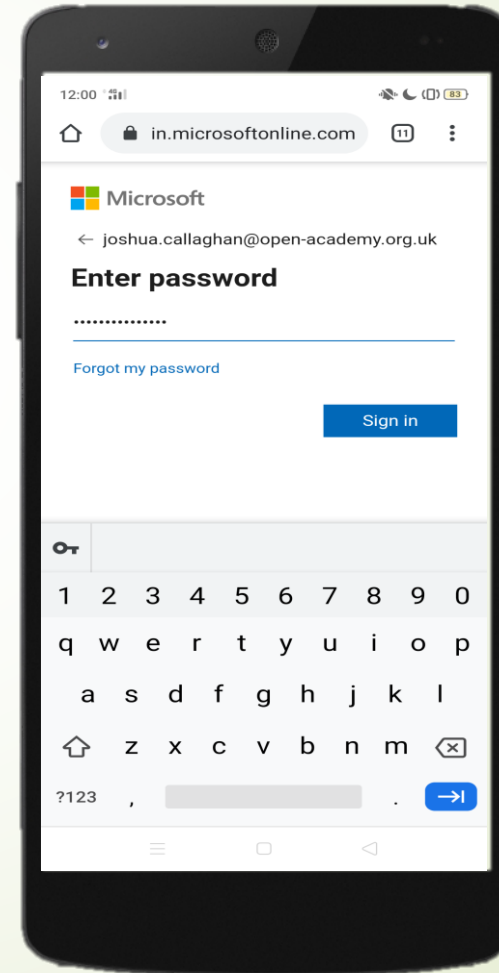
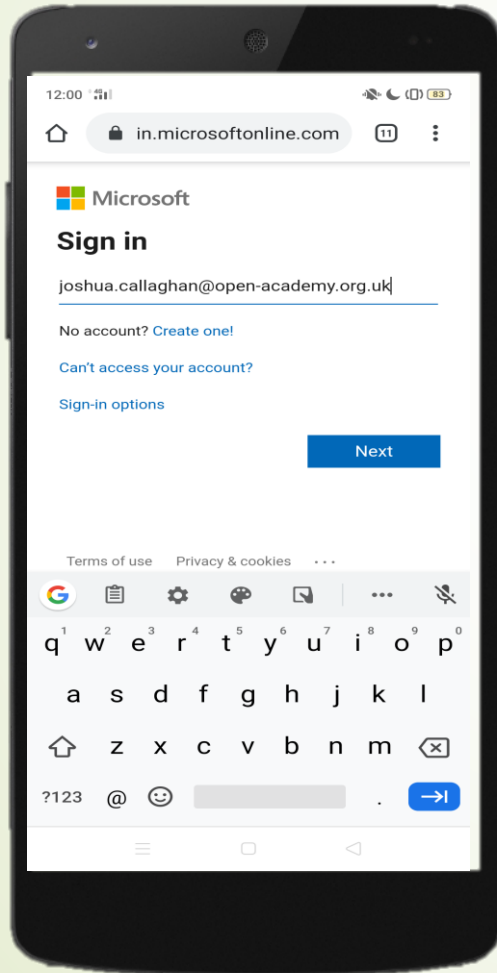
Open up the app store and search and download “sims student”



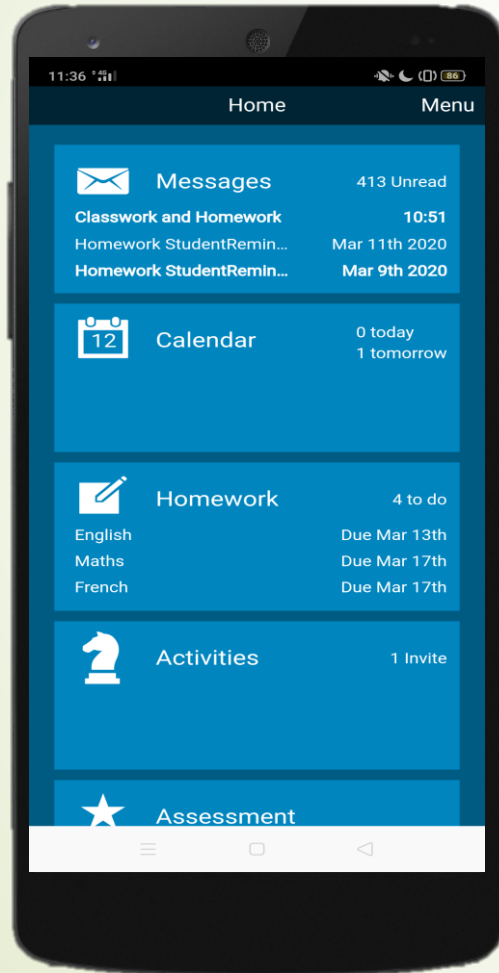
In the app, click “sign in” and then
“sign in with office 365”



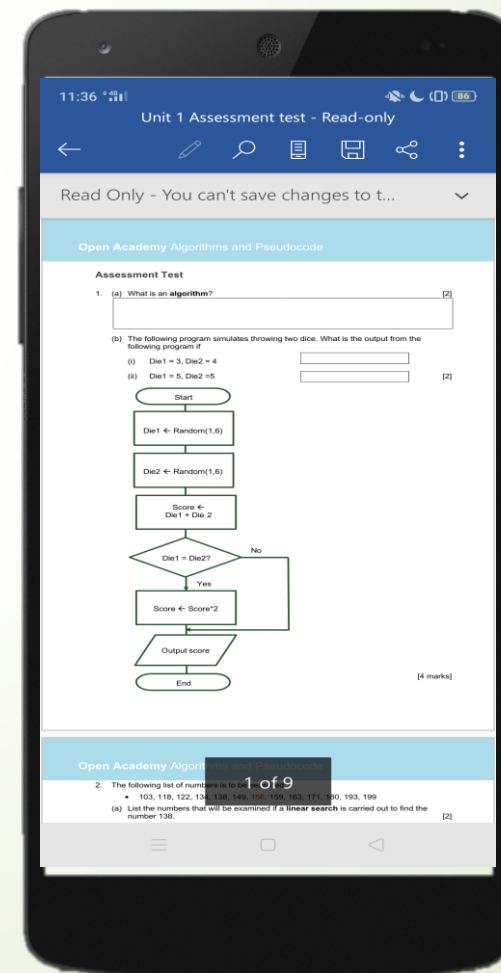
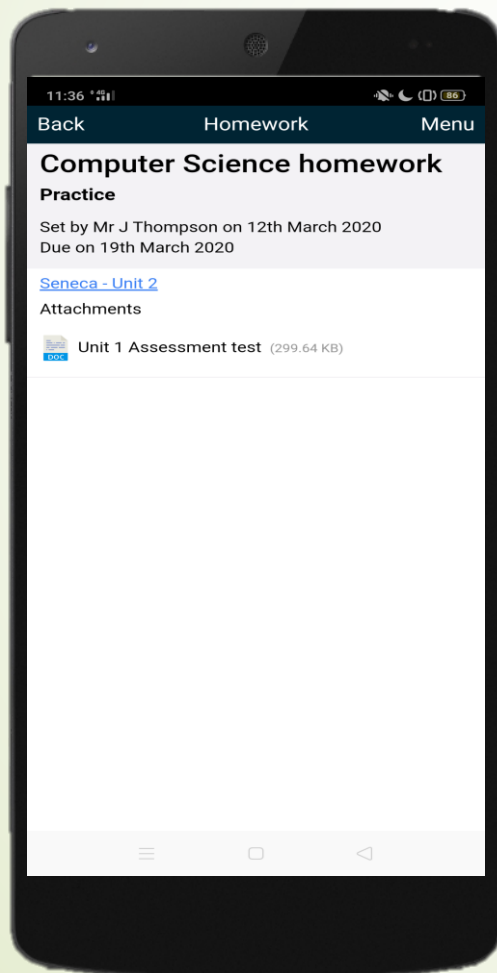
Enter the school email followed by the password. (This is identical to the normal laptop/Pc log in)




Now logged in to the app , press

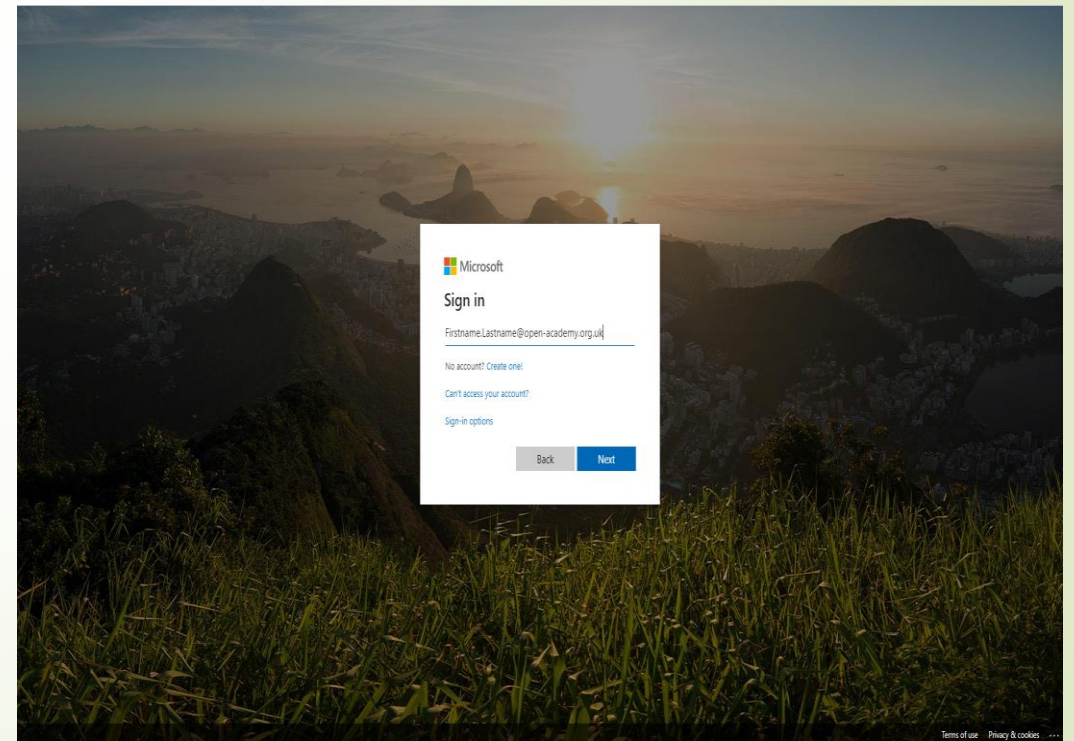
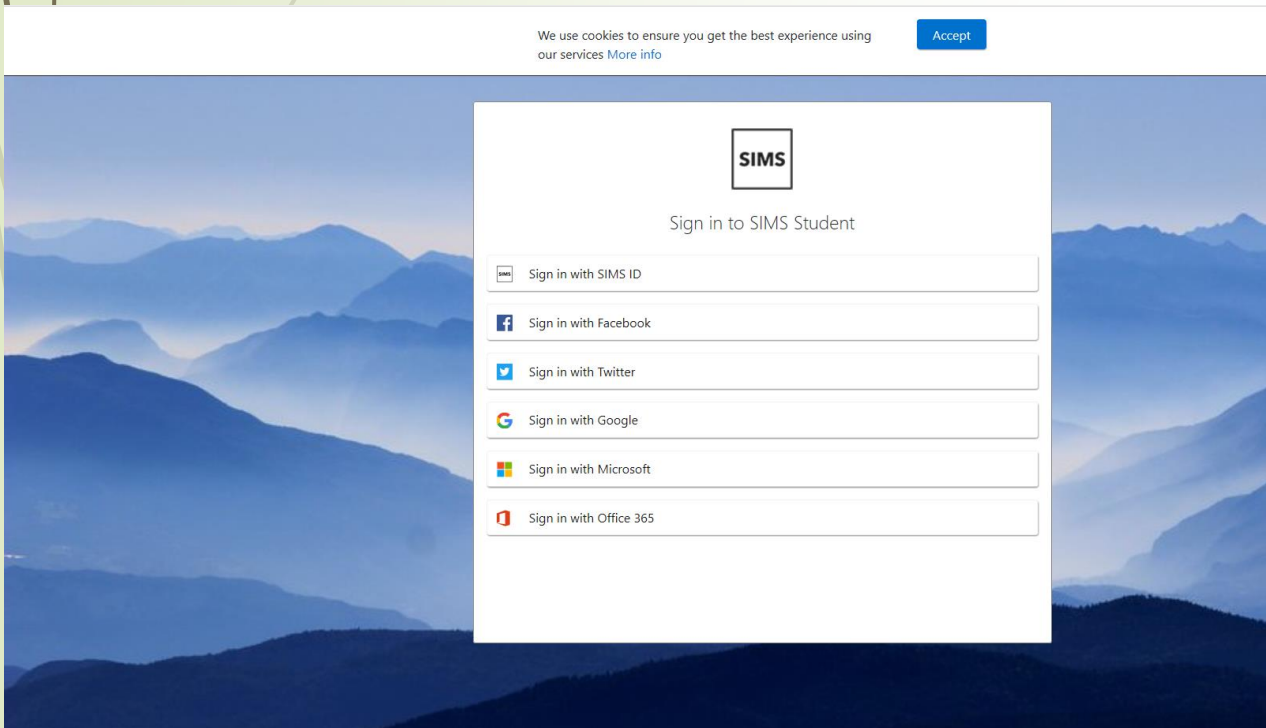
