Welcome, or welcome back to all for the new academic year.

My only focus this week is on the sad announcement of the death of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II. As a community, our thoughts and prayers are with her family at this difficult time.

The students have had time to reflect and pray for the Queen this morning and Mark, our Chaplain, is always available to give support and encouragement to students or indeed anyone in our community, who may be affected by this news or where it might act as a reminder about loss from their own lives. The pastoral team are also always here for your child no matter what the issue.

We would like to remind you that we will remain open throughout the period of public mourning. It is likely that the day of the Queen's funeral will be a public holiday and therefore schools will be closed on that day. Once we know more, we will write to you again.

As we all come to terms with what happened, we know that some children will be affected by this in particular. We will keep the school routine as normal as possible, allowing the children opportunities to talk if they want to.
