## A. Books and Reading...

As well as our own read-a-long there are a number of authors and publishers sharing reading content online - from reading their books, virtual book clubs, creative writing competitions and more.

### B. The Open Youth Trust have an active program over Easter...

The Open youth team have organised and have started running online classes via the Zoom app which young people can sign up to. Staff are doing live streams and are creating regular videos around wellbeing, climbing, dance, creative writing, arts and crafts as well as lots more to keep young people engaged.

During the Covid-19 crisis they are utilising social media on Instagram, Tiktok, Twitter and Facebook @OPENNorwich to engage more young people.

- These classes and online sessions are for young people aged 11 -17. Our Junior Dance is for ages 7 - 11.
- The sessions are open to all young people whether they have participated in activities with OPEN before or are new to the organisation.

# D. Project work

Why not set them off on a project? See the attached Pineapple project or see below - remember these are just project ideas - We would encourage students to use these ideas for anything they are interested in!

The following is a suggestion based around the virus - they may be sick of it, they may be fascinated by it however, it is a good example of how to construct a project - you can use this as a framework to create similar activities to explore absolutely anything!

Activities could be loosely shaped to fill any subject (Coronavirus as the example) eg:

**History** – Design a video/lesson/activities that could be used in a History lesson 100 years from now. How would the lesson describe what it was to be a child during **the coronavirus pandemic**?

**English** – design a newspaper to run stories on how *the coronavirus pandemic* started and age it using wet teabags

**Science** – the science behind *viruses* – design a fun comic strip to explain how virus infect the body and how they make copies of themselves

**Art** – design a board game loosely based around *virus*. You win points/go forward on the board if you wash your hands well, sneeze into your elbow etc.

**Food tech** – You have a basic larder of ingredients – design a 3 course meal using those ingredients only!

As we approach this time of the year, we are reminded of an amazing act of love and sacrifice. Christians all over the world will be remembering and celebrating the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
